## CARES Act and other COVID-19 Updates

- The tax-filing deadline was pushed back to July 15<sup>th</sup>. If you have already completed your taxes, you can file now and if you owe, the bill is not due until July.
- Congress approved a second round of Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loans. If you are a business owner (or self-employed), let us know if you need help filing for this loan program.
